ACCOMMODATION

Comfortable lounge with comfy sofa, satellite TV, DVD Player, French doors leading on to garden, integral kitchen.

Double bedroom (with twin beds), en-suite shower room with toilet, wash hand basin and washing machine.

OUTSIDE: To the front of the property is an attractive gravelled sitting area with garden furniture, hedging and pot plants. A good sized garden is to the rear of the cottage with lawned area, barbecue and garden furniture.

Les Lavandes is adjacent to our own property, so if you have any queries or require any help at all during your stay, we are on hand to assist.

We are in a peaceful location, yet only 2kms from the ancient Medieval town of Malestroit. We are situated at the end of a quiet lane, and surrounded by beautiful countryside. To the rear of the property is a good sized garden with lawn, barbecue and garden furniture. Superb country views to the front of the property.

Malestroit is a very picturesque Medieval town, has the Nantes/Brest canal running through its centre, and from which it is only a 30 minute drive to Vannes on the coast. Apart from the usual small shops in the centre, there are three supermarkets and many good restaurants to choose from.

Most sports are catered for, and there is a large inland lake at Ploermel, which is only a ten minute drive, with man-made sandy beaches, ideal for young children.

There are water sports, (wind-surfing etc.), and also a 9 hole golf course.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q ~ What credit cards are accepted in France?

A ~ Visa and Mastercard are accepted in most shops and supermarkets. Several cashpoints in most towns.

Q ~ What sports are available in the area?

A ~ Ploermel (approx 10 miles away) has a large inland lake offering all water sports, a man-made sandy beach. For children - swings, slides etc., paddling and swimming. Windsurfing and sailing, golf course and horse riding.

Malestroit (approx 2km away) has tennis, archery and canoeing.

Monteneuf (3 miles away) has fishing and tennis.

Q ~ How far away is the coast?

A ~ Nearest beach is Damgan, which is approximately 30 minutes by car. Superb coastline with a variety of all types of beaches to suit everyone. Sea trips available around the Gulf of Morbihan.

Travelling time from ferry ports...

ROSCOFF ~ 2.5 - 3hrs CAEN ~ 3 - 4hrs

St MALO ~ 1.5 - 2hrs CALAIS ~ 5.5 - 6 hours

CHERBOURG ~ 3 - 4hrs

Q ~ Shopping?

A ~ Shops are closed all day Monday with the exception of the supermarkets. However, in larger towns such as Vannes, Rennes etc most shops are open. The majority of shops close for lunch between 12 and 2pm.

Q ~ Healthcare?

A ~ Hospitals at Malestroit, Ploermel and Carentoir. Doctors and Dentist at Malestroit.

Q ~ Public Holidays?

A ~ 1 January, 13 April, 1 May, 8 May, 21 May, 1 June, 14 July, 15 August, 1 November, 11 November, 25 December.

Q ~ Trains?

A ~ Stations at Rennes, Redon, Questembert and Vannes. Bus service from Ploermel to Rennes liaising with train service.

Q ~ Flights?

A ~ Nearest airport is at Rennes, which is about a 35 minute drive. We can pick up and drop you back to the airport (£ 10 for our expenses per visit to the airport). Please enquire if you need this service.


MALESTROIT
